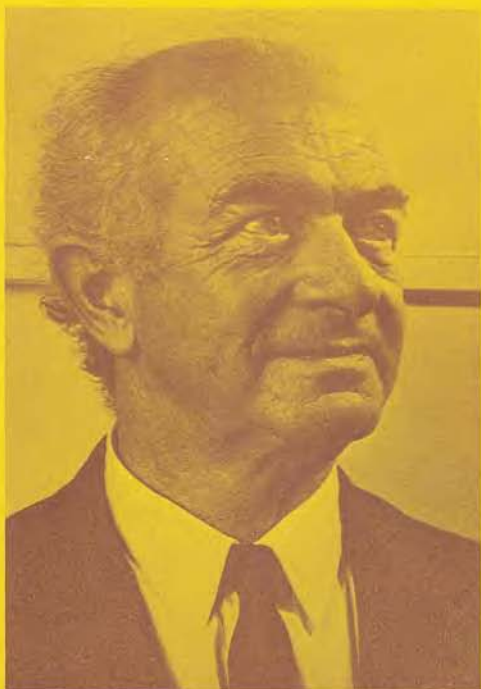
# 8<sup>TH</sup> Midwest Regional Meeting- American Chemical Society
